Connecting your Domain to Microsoft Office 365

Prerequisites

- Your DNS records are not hosted externally or 3rd party
- Your domain nameservers are using **ns1.vdns.au** and **ns2.vdns.au**

To connect the domain to Microsoft Office 365

1. Log into Domain Panel: <https://domains.micron21.com/login>
2. Navigate to “**Domains**” in the side panel.
3. Click the Name of your domain name then scroll down and click the “**Manage DNS**” button.
4. You can then click the “**Add New Record**” button to create a new entry.
5. Set the DNS type from one of the DropDown options (listed above) and enter any required details from your host.

Example DNS records provided by Microsoft:
